Who are the Friends of Crowborough Citizens Advice?

Crowborough Citizens Advice is part of Wealden Citizens Advice which includes the Uckfield and Hailsham bureaux. It is an autonomous body giving advice by well trained volunteers who are supported by qualified paid staff.

The help given to clients is becoming increasingly complex and is very dependent on reliable and up to date computer technology. Some of our funding comes from Local Authority grants together with other funding sources, but there is always a shortfall.

The Friends is an independent charity which raises money specifically to support the Crowborough Bureau. The charity provides funds for equipment and services that cannot be met by Wealden Citizens Advice.

To raise funds we hold a number of social events throughout the year that have included quiz nights, open gardens, concerts, etc. The prize draw is a key part of our fundraising activities.

How does the Prize Draw operate?

The cost of entering the prize draw is £16.00 per year. Of this sum half goes towards prizes and half into the friends' funds. Entry can be at any point in the year and participants will be entered into the next draw. Payment can be by Standing Order, BACS, or cheque (payable to the Friends of Crowborough Citizens Advice). We prefer payment by Standing Order because this considerably reduces costs and administration.

At each draw the available prize fund is divided into three prizes of 50%, 30% and 20%. Draws take place at the Annual General Meeting in July, and just before Christmas.

To increase our ability to support the Charity we ask that you consider a donation on top of the standard £16 membership. If you are a taxpayer we can reclaim an additional 25% of this additional donation from the Inland Revenue as Gift Aid.
